Chairman's Message/Message du président du conseil

In my message last fall in *The Canadian Mover*, I wrote about the tangible value of membership in the Canadian Association of Movers. Over the last six months, CAM, through its Board of Directors and staff, has been focused on establishing the Certified Canadian Mover Program as a standard of performance for CAM members. I believe this program is a tool professional movers will use to distinguish themselves from less-than-professional competition, and consumers will use to identify professional movers in order to get a high-quality move.

The Office of Consumer Affairs at Industry Canada began this initiative in September 2002, with the formation of a committee of industry stakeholders. The goal of the committee was to generate guidelines for movers in their relationships with consumers, and a checklist for consumers to help them select a professional mover.

That goal was achieved in early March 2004, after much negotiation among the parties involved and input from CAM's members. Industry Canada has just published *Good-Practice Guidelines for Movers* and *Consumer Checklist for Choosing a Moving Company*. You'll find copies of these documents in this issue. Through its participation on this committee, CAM has formed a working partnership with the Canadian Council of Better Business Bureaus to assist in arbitrating disputes.

At the same time that these programs were being developed, CAM developed its *Certified Canadian Mover Program* based on CAM's *Code of Ethics* and the principles in the *Guidelines* and *Checklist*. These principles guide movers in:

- Communications with the consumer
- Provision and use of estimates
- Service delivery to the customer
- Settlement of claims
- Management of facilities

Dans le dernier numéro de *Le déménageur canadien*, je disais que les avantages concrets constituent une valeur pour les membres de l'Association canadienne des déménageurs. Au cours des six derniers mois, le conseil d'administration et le personnel de l'ACD ont concentré leurs efforts sur la mise sur pied du Programme de certification des déménageurs canadiens qui établit des normes de qualité pour les membres de l'ACD. Je pense que le programme est un outil de choix pour les déménageurs professionnels qui veulent se distinguer des concurrents moins conscients et pour les consommateurs qui cherchent le déménageur professionnel le plus susceptible de leur assurer un déménagement satisfaisant.

L'initiative de ce projet revient au Bureau de la consommation d'Industrie Canada qui, en septembre 2002, a formé un comité composé de représentants de l'industrie. L'objectif du comité consistait à dégager des lignes directrices sur les relations des déménageurs avec les consommateurs et à établir une liste de vérification pour aider les consommateurs à choisir un déménageur professionnel.

Après de nombreuses séances de négociation entre les représentants de l'industrie et après consultation auprès des membres de l'ACD, l'objectif a été atteint au début de mars 2004. Industrie Canada vient de publier les *Lignes directrices sur les bonnes pratiques pour les déménageurs canadiens* et la *Liste de vérification des consommateurs pour choisir une entreprise de déménagement*, dont vous trouverez une copie dans ce numéro. Dans le cadre de sa participation à ce comité, l'ACD a formé un partenariat de travail avec le Conseil canadien des bureaux d'éthique commerciale et apporte son soutien dans le règlement des différends.

Pendant la même période, l'ACD a mis au point son Programme de certification des déménageurs canadiens en se basant sur son code d'éthique et sur les principes

President's Message/Message du président

The Canadian Association of Movers' national-office staff has devoted much of its time over the last year to the development of the Certified Canadian Mover Program (CCMP) and to providing input to the Industry Canada committee responsible for the development of *Good-Practice Guidelines for Movers* and the *Consumer Checklist for Choosing a Moving Company*. Together with CAM's Code of Ethics, these two documents are cornerstones of our program.

We received input from CAM members across the country in the development of the CCMP. We have used information gathered through that process, along with input from consumers and moving-industry stakeholders, in building the program.

The Canadian Association of Movers — board of directors, members and staff — developed this program to benefit movers and consumers alike. It is intended to be simple in its concept and to work within CAM's resources. It relies on the ongoing good performance of a mover to maintain program membership.

This changes CAM's role in several significant areas. CAM must:

- monitor information that members provide, in order to ensure that it is complete, accurate and up to date;
- provide current information to members and consumers as to who is (and who is not) a Certified Canadian Mover; and
- record all complaints received, and ensure that any against members are resolved.

Raising the Bar for Movers and Consumers

The level of consumer complaints about movers has concerned all stakeholders in the Canadian moving and storage industry: reputable movers, consumer associations, trade associations and government. To address these concerns and to act as a complement to legal protections already in place, the Office of Consumer Affairs, Industry Canada formed a working group of moving-industry professionals, consumer group representatives and government officials to develop good-practice guidelines for reputable movers, and an associated consumer checklist. It is hoped that the existence of the *Good-Practice Guidelines for Canadian Movers* and the *Consumer Checklist* will assist movers in identifying and adhering to high standards and will aid consumers in selecting reputable, ethical and professional movers. CAM's Code of Ethics, the *Good-Practice Guidelines for Canadian Movers* and the *Consumer Checklist* are the core elements on which CAM's Certified Canadian Mover Program is based. (Complete information for the Program can be found on CAM's website at www.mover.net.)

Good-Practice Guidelines for Canadian Movers

Canadian movers wishing to ensure continued good relations with their customers agree to:

- Provide customers with a pamphlet that outlines customer and mover rights and responsibilities, mover liability for loss or damage, optional programs available, limitations on



liability and additional costs associated with each level of liability. The pamphlet should be written in plain language and be easy to understand. Where local-move customers request an estimate by telephone, movers shall agree to offer to provide the pamphlet by mail, fax, or email.

- Provide written estimates of costs that describe the shipment and the cost of all services requested by the customer. The estimate shall be on company letterhead, stating the name, telephone number and address of the company, a full estimate of the number of boxes to be moved, the size and value of items, including the cost per hour or flat rate, terms of payment, and timing of services to be provided. The estimate should be signed by both the company representative and the customer.
- Abide by the terms of the estimate as provided to the customer, in compliance with all applicable law.
- For long-distance moves, tag all goods and prepare, prior to the shipment leaving the residence, a descriptive inventory of the goods to be moved that shall be presented for signature to the customer or his authorized representative who is present at origin for loading and again at destination as the goods are unloaded. A copy of this descriptive inventory shall be provided to the customer prior to shipment. Any existing damage to goods shall be noted in the inventory.
- Provide customers with a bill of

lading at the time of pickup that clearly delineates critical customer service details, such as the terms and amount of payment and the date of delivery.

- When charges are based on weight, determine the weight of each shipment by the use of a certified scale at origin and if requested, furnish evidence of that weight to the customer. When the actual weight exceeds the estimated weight by more than 10 per cent, the mover will, upon request, perform a "re-weigh" of the shipment and furnish evidence of the re-weigh to the customer.
- Make reasonable efforts to fulfil the arrangements made for servicing a shipment, including the performance of pickup and delivery as agreed upon. Keep customers advised of any service delays and provide them with information as to when service may be expected to be performed. This should include providing the customer with the company contact name and telephone number.
- Ensure the customer receives a copy of the bill of lading or invoice on delivery, with a clear description of charges and services provided.
- Acknowledge, in writing within 30 days, the receipt of a written loss or damage claim or delay claim, and agree to thereafter pay, decline, make a firm compromise offer or advise the claimant of the status of the claim and any reason for a delay in making a final disposition within 120 days of receipt of any documented claim for loss or damage, or for any documented claim for delay in delivery beyond the dates shown on the bill of lading, when the claim is filed by the customer within 60 days (long-distance moves) or 30 days (local moves) after delivery.
- Promptly and fairly attempt to resolve disputes concerning loss or damage claims to household goods, through in-house complaints-handling and external dispute-resolution processes as appropriate and available. In terms of guidance on what constitutes a fair dispute

Le nombre de plaintes formulées par les consommateurs relativement aux déménageurs a été un sujet de préoccupation pour tous les intervenants de l'industrie canadienne du déménagement et de l'entreposage : déménageurs honnêtes, groupes de consommateurs, associations professionnelles et gouvernements. Pour répondre à ces préoccupations, le Bureau de la consommation d'Industrie Canada a formé un groupe de travail multilatéral composé de spécialistes de l'industrie du déménagement, de représentants de groupes de consommateurs et de fonctionnaires des gouvernements et lui a confié la mission d'élaborer des *Lignes directrices sur les bonnes pratiques pour les déménageurs canadiens* ainsi qu'une *Liste de vérification des consommateurs pour choisir une entreprise de déménagement*, ces documents devant s'ajouter aux protections légales déjà en place. Il est à souhaiter que les *Lignes directrices* et la *Liste de vérification* aideront les déménageurs à définir et à respecter des normes élevées et aideront les consommateurs à choisir des déménageurs honnêtes, fiables et professionnels. Les Lignes directrices sur les bonnes pratiques pour les déménageurs canadiens peuvent également être utilisées comme élément des programmes d'accréditation de l'industrie du déménagement.

Lignes directrices sur les bonnes pratiques pour les déménageurs canadiens

Les déménageurs canadiens qui souhaitent entretenir de bonnes relations avec leurs clients conviennent :

- De remettre aux clients une brochure énonçant les droits et les responsabilités du consommateur et du déménageur ainsi que de la documentation sur la responsabilité du déménageur pour les pertes ou les dommages, les divers programmes offerts, les limites de responsabilité et les coûts additionnels liés à chaque niveau de responsabilité. Le texte de la brochure doit être écrit dans un langage simple et facile à lire. Si le client téléphone pour demander un devis pour un déménagement local, le

déménageur conviendra d'offrir au client de lui faire parvenir la brochure par la poste, par télécopieur ou par message électronique.

- De remettre des devis écrits des coûts; les devis décriront les coûts du transport et de tous les services demandés par le client. Le devis doit être présenté sur papier à en-tête de l'entreprise et mentionner son nom, son numéro de téléphone et son adresse, comporter une estimation complète du nombre de boîtes à déménager, de la taille et de la valeur des articles, le tarif horaire ou le montant forfaitaire pour le déménagement ainsi que les modalités de paiement et les dates des services à fournir. Le devis doit être signé par le représentant de l'entreprise de déménagement et par le client.
- De respecter les modalités inscrites au devis remis au client, conformément aux lois applicables.
- Pour un déménagement long courrier, d'étiqueter tous les articles et de dresser, avant de quitter la résidence, un inventaire descriptif des biens à déménager; l'inventaire doit être soumis pour signature au client ou à son représentant autorisé présent au lieu d'origine pour le chargement et également au lieu de destination une fois les biens déchargés. Une copie de l'inventaire descriptif doit être remis au client avant l'expédition. L'inventaire doit mentionner tous les dommages existants.
- De remettre au client, au moment du chargement, un connaissance qui énonce en détail les services à rendre au client ainsi que le montant et les modalités des paiements et la date de livraison.
- Si les frais sont calculés en fonction du poids, déterminer, au lieu d'origine, le poids des biens transportés à l'aide d'une balance homologuée et sur demande, remettre au client une preuve du poids. Si le poids réel dépasse de plus de 10 p.cent le poids estimé, le déménageur procède, sur demande, à une nouvelle pesée des biens transportés et en fournit la preuve au client.

• De faire des efforts raisonnables pour respecter les dispositions prises pour l'expédition, notamment d'effectuer le ramassage et la livraison de la manière convenue. D'aviser le client des retards de service et de le tenir informé du moment où il est prévu que le travail pourra être exécuté. Cet avis doit donner au client le nom et le numéro de téléphone de la personne-ressource de l'entreprise de déménagement.

• De s'assurer que le client reçoit une copie du connaissment ou de la facture au moment de la livraison; ce document doit donner une description claire des services fournis et des frais.

• De tenter de régler rapidement et équitablement les différends relatifs aux réclamations pour pertes ou dommages aux articles de ménage, soit par l'intermédiaire d'un service interne de traitement des plaintes ou par un processus externe de règlement des différends, selon ce qui est approprié ou possible dans chaque cas. Il est recommandé aux entreprises de déménagement de s'inspirer du document rédigé au nom des ministres fédéral, provinciaux et territoriaux intitulé « Gestion des plaintes des consommateurs : guide à l'intention des entreprises canadiennes » pour savoir ce qui constitue un processus équitable de résolution des différends; le document peut être téléchargé à [http://strategis.ic.gc.ca/epic/internet/inoca-bc.nsf/vwapj/GestiondesPlaintes.pdf](http://strategis.ic.gc.ca/epic/internet/inoca-bc.nsf/vwapj/GestiondesPlaintes.pdf/$FILE/GestiondesPlaintes.pdf) ou consulté en ligne à l'adresse <http://strategis.ic.gc.ca/epic/internet/inoca-bc.nsf/vwGeneratedInterF/ca01763f.html>.

• De communiquer avec le public par des annonces, des devis et de la documentation promotionnelle justes et véridiques sur les services qu'ils peuvent rendre.

- Communicate with the public through fair and accurate advertisements, estimates and sales literature regarding the services that may be performed.
 - If working in conjunction with other agents, ensure that these agents also comply with the above commitments.
 - Maintain and clean facilities and equipment regularly in accordance with good industry practices.

Consumer Checklist for Choosing a Moving Company

Much of the stress that comes with moving can be relieved by hiring the right people to do the job. When choosing a moving company, it is wise to do some research about moving companies before making a selection, and to ask your family and friends for the names of companies they recommend. It is also useful to call organizations such as the Better Business Bureau for a list of suggested movers. You may want to find out if the mover is a member of an association of movers or a certified reputable mover program. It is a good idea to ask at least three movers for estimates and check references, so that you will have a better idea of your options.

Start with these questions

- Does the company know about and agree to abide by the terms of the *Good-Practice Guidelines for Canadian Movers*? Does the company provide you with a pamphlet that outlines customer and mover rights and responsibilities, written material regarding mover liability for loss or damage, optional programs available, limitations on liability and additional costs associated with each level of liability?
- Is the company insured? Ask them to provide you with the insurance company’s name and policy number.

- Does the company have their own equipment, or will a subcontractor or another company be providing the service? Which company? What is their record like? Get references.
- Who will be providing services at the end of the move, such as unpacking, claims settlement, and storage? Is it the same as the original company, an affiliated van line, or someone else?
- If your belongings will be left overnight in a moving van, will the van be kept in a secure facility? Be sure to use a company that uses vehicles designed for household goods moving and storage.
- Whose storage facilities will be used — the company’s or a third party’s? It’s a good idea to visit and check the company’s offices, storage facilities and vehicles before your move.
- Does the mover have a workers’ compensation board certificate? If not, you may end up paying for any employee injuries incurred during the move.

Ask for an estimate

- For a long-distance move, a reputable mover will want to inspect your belongings to help prepare a competent quote. If a company says the inspection isn’t necessary or wants to provide a quote over the telephone, you’re probably better off dealing with someone else. Make sure that everything that needs to be moved is shown to the movers during the estimate, and find out how much it will cost if you need to add any items on the day of the move.
- When asking for an estimate, be sure to give the mover precise information about the locations of your old and new residences. Notify the movers of obstacles, such as stairs or elevators, that will require special navigation. To avoid being charged more later on, give the movers as much information as possible.
- It is helpful to make an inventory of everything you want moved, from the basement to the attic, and ensure that special arrangements are made

for specific goods (e.g., electronics, appliances, pianos).

- Be sure to get estimates and all other assurances in writing, including the delivery date, as well as the full name of the person you spoke with.
- The estimate should be on company letterhead, stating the name, telephone number and address of the company, a full estimate of the number of boxes to be moved, the size and value of items, including the cost per hour or flat rate, terms of payment, and timing of services to be provided. If items are being moved out of the country, be sure to obtain the name and address of the moving agents who will be handling your move at the destination.
- For a local move, the estimate should provide the number of hours the move will take to complete. Make sure the estimate is dated and includes the date of the move. Don’t sign a contract unless these details are spelled out in writing.
- Don’t be afraid to negotiate. Beware of a price that is much lower than others. This could be an indicator of substandard service or higher charges to come later.
- Beware also of movers who offer to forgo the Goods and Services Tax (GST) or who accept only cash payments. These may be indicators of an unscrupulous mover and one who is unlikely to pay claims, let alone deliver your goods.

Get the details

- Who is responsible for packing? Ask about liability if you pack the items yourself.
- Can boxes from other places like a grocery store be used?
- Should all owner-packed boxes be sealed and labelled?
- Are any licences or customs documents required, e.g., at border crossings? And who will prepare them?
- Are there special seasonal rates or any other factors that may affect the cost of the move? It can be less expensive to move between October and June, or at mid-month.
- If a deposit is required, will the money be put in trust, as is required

Liste de vérification des consommateurs pour choisir une entreprise de déménagement

Il est possible de s'épargner une grande partie du stress provoqué par un déménagement en retenant les services de la bonne entreprise pour faire ce travail. Avant de choisir une entreprise de déménagement, il est sage de faire des recherches sur les diverses entreprises avant d'arrêter son choix et de demander aux membres de votre famille et à vos amis les noms d'entreprises qu'ils recommandent. Il est aussi utile de communiquer avec des organisations comme le Bureau d'éthique commerciale pour obtenir une liste des déménageurs suggérés. Vous pouvez demander si l'entreprise est membre d'une association de déménageurs ou si elle souscrit à un programme fiable d'accréditation de déménageurs.

C'est une bonne idée de demander un devis à au moins trois déménageurs et de vérifier les références pour avoir un meilleur aperçu des choix qui s'offrent à vous.

Commencez par ces questions

- Est-ce que l'entreprise connaît et respecte les *Lignes directrices sur les bonnes pratiques pour les déménageurs canadiens*? Vous remet-elle une brochure énonçant les droits et les responsabilités du consommateur et du déménageur? De la documentation sur la responsabilité du déménageur pour les pertes ou les dommages, les divers programmes offerts, les limites de responsabilité et les coûts additionnels liés à chaque niveau de responsabilité?
- L'entreprise est-elle assurée? Demandez que l'on vous donne le nom de la compagnie d'assurance et le numéro de police.
- Est-ce que l'entreprise possède son propre équipement, ou est-ce que les services seront fournis par un sous-traitant ou une autre entreprise? Dans ce cas, de quelle entreprise s'agit-il? Quels sont les antécédents de cette entreprise? Obtenez des références.
- Qui fournira les services à destination, par exemple le déballage, le règlement des réclamations, l'entreposage? Est-ce l'entreprise avec laquelle le contrat est conclu, une entreprise affiliée ou une autre entreprise?

- Si votre mobilier doit passer la nuit dans un camion de déménagement, le camion sera-t-il stationné dans un endroit sécuritaire? Assurez-vous de faire appel à une entreprise qui utilise des véhicules conçus pour le déménagement et l'entreposage d'articles de ménage.
- L'entrepôt utilisé appartient-il à l'entreprise ou à un tiers? C'est une bonne idée de visiter et d'inspecter les bureaux, l'entrepôt et les véhicules de l'entreprise avant le déménagement.
- L'entreprise de déménagement est-elle titulaire d'un certificat de la Commission des accidents du travail? Sinon, vous pourriez devoir indemniser les employés blessés pendant le déménagement.

Demandez un devis

- S'il s'agit d'un déménagement long-courrier, un déménageur sérieux voudra inspecter vos biens pour être en mesure de préparer un devis fiable. Si un déménageur affirme que l'inspection est inutile ou veut faire un devis au téléphone, il est probablement préférable de vous adresser à une autre entreprise. Lors de la préparation du devis, assurez-vous de montrer au déménageur tout ce qui doit être déménagé et demandez combien il vous en coûtera si vous devez ajouter des articles le jour du déménagement.
- Quand vous demandez un devis, assurez-vous de donner au déménageur les renseignements précis sur l'emplacement de votre ancienne résidence et de la nouvelle. Informez-le des obstacles comme les escaliers ou les escaliers mécaniques qui exigent des dispositions spéciales. Pour éviter que les frais augmentent, donnez au déménageur le plus de renseignements possible.

- Il est utile de dresser un inventaire de tout ce qui doit être déménagé, du sous-sol au grenier, et de vous assurer que des dispositions spéciales sont prises pour les articles qui exigent une attention spéciale, par exemple l'équipement électronique, les électroménagers, un piano.
- Assurez-vous que le devis et tous les autres renseignements vous sont donnés par écrit, notamment la date de livraison et le nom complet de la personne avec qui vous avez discuté.
- Le devis doit être présenté sur papier à en-tête de l'entreprise et mentionner son nom, son numéro de téléphone et son adresse, comporter une estimation complète du nombre de boîtes à déménager, de la taille et de la valeur des articles, le tarif horaire ou le montant forfaitaire pour le déménagement ainsi que les modalités de paiement et les dates des services à fournir. Si les articles doivent être déménagés à l'extérieur du pays, assurez-vous d'obtenir le nom et l'adresse des agents qui s'occuperont du déménagement à destination.
- Pour un déménagement local, le devis doit mentionner le nombre d'heures que le déménagement exigera. Assurez-vous que le devis est daté et que la date du déménagement est inscrite. Ne signez pas de contrat à moins que ces renseignements ne soient bel et bien inscrits.
- N'hésitez pas à négocier. Méfiez-vous si un prix est beaucoup plus bas que les autres. Cela pourrait signifier que les services seront inférieurs à la norme ou que des charges plus élevées s'ajouteront par la suite.
- Méfiez-vous aussi des déménageurs qui offrent de ne pas exiger le paiement de la taxe sur les produits et services (TPS) et de ceux qui acceptent uniquement les paiements en espèces. Il s'agit souvent de déménageurs peu scrupuleux ou de déménageurs qui refusent de payer les réclamations ou même de livrer vos objets.

Obtenez des renseignements détaillés

- Qui a la responsabilité de l'emballage? Informez-vous de la responsabilité si vous faites l'emballage vous-même.
- Est-il possible d'utiliser des boîtes d'autres fournisseurs que le déménageur, par exemple des boîtes obtenues à l'épicerie?
- Toutes les boîtes préparées par le propriétaire doivent-elles être scellées et étiquetées?
- Des permis ou des documents de douane sont-ils nécessaires, par exemple pour traverser la frontière? Qui doit les préparer?
- Le coût du déménagement est-il affecté par des tarifs saisonniers spéciaux ou par d'autres facteurs? Il peut coûter moins cher de déménager entre octobre et juin, ou au milieu d'un mois.
- Si un dépôt est demandé, l'argent sera-t-il déposé dans un compte en fidéicommis comme l'exigent certaines provinces et certains territoires? Le dépôt est-il remboursable? Clarifiez les modes de paiement dès le début.
- Quelles sont les modalités en place pour protéger vos biens en vertu de la politique de l'entreprise de

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- in some provinces and territories? Is it refundable? Clarify methods of payment at the outset.
- What are the terms and conditions of protecting your goods under the mover's replacement-value protection policy, including coverage for those goods you packed yourself? Is there a deductible, and if so, how much is it?

What is replacement-value protection?

Even with the best mover, you need to know how you can protect yourself:

- First check with your insurance agent/broker to find out if your existing household policy provides coverage during the move, and if so, what the deductible is. Make sure that your policy provides you with "all risks" coverage, because any less coverage leaves you exposed.
- Then check with the moving company for the cost of replacement-value protection. This means that the moving company agrees to be legally liable up to an amount that represents your estimate of the value of your property being moved. Often that amount is arrived at by multiplying each pound of weight of your shipment by \$10 — but that is just a rule of thumb. Make sure that the total amount of

declared valuation is enough to replace all of your furniture and personal effects. Make sure that you get replacement-value protection and **NOT** depreciated value only.

- Ask the moving company for written material that explains how replacement-value protection works.
- Ask the moving company for information on how to make a claim and what the time limit is for making a claim.
- Identify the difference of liability between owner-packed and mover-packed cartons and special-care items (e.g., glass, marble, and other "at owner's risk" items that are not packed professionally).
- If you don't buy replacement-value protection, the moving company is usually liable only up to 60 cents per pound for any article that is destroyed or lost. (For a typical television set, that's about \$30.)
- **Be sure you have adequate protection either through your own insurance policy or through the moving company's replacement-value protection policy.**

Making the best of your moving day

- Be ready when the movers arrive. Have everything ready to go, as you will be charged an hourly rate for

the time the movers wait.

- Make sure both your origin and destination locations are ready. If you are moving to an apartment, book the elevator in the apartment building and notify your landlord or building manager of the arrival time of your movers. Arrange for street parking if needed.
- For long-distance moves, the *Good Practice Guidelines for Canadian Movers* stipulate that all items must be tagged and listed by the mover, with a copy of the inventory supplied to you for your records. Be sure to keep a copy of this inventory. When you arrive at your new destination, check off each piece, and note any changes to the inventory prior to signing it. Otherwise, your mover may decline your claim for lost or damaged items.
- For a local move, you should make an inventory of goods to be moved, and supervise the loading and unloading or arrange for someone else to supervise. If goods are damaged or lost, make sure it's noted on the inventory, and notify the mover quickly. Normally, claims must be made within 30 days for local moves and within 60 days for long-distance moves.
- When the loading has been completed, do a walk-through of your premises to ensure that everything has been loaded and nothing is left in closets, behind doors, in attics or garages.
- Take any personal, important documents with you. Back up your computer data, and take the data and the computer with you.
- Take all of your valuables (e.g., jewellery, prescriptions, artwork) with you, and make special arrangements for perishables (e.g., food, plants) that may be affected by heat or cold. Make appropriate arrangements for your pets.
- When the unloading has been completed, do a walk-through of your premises and all hallways and pathways into your premises, as well as the moving vehicle, to ensure that everything has been unloaded.
- Enjoy your new home!

Qu'est-ce que la clause de valeur de remplacement?

Même si vous retenez la meilleure entreprise de déménagement, vous devez savoir comment vous protéger :

- Vérifiez d'abord auprès de votre agent ou de votre courtier d'assurance si votre police d'assurance habitation vous couvre pendant le déménagement et si oui, informez-vous du montant de la franchise. Assurez-vous que votre police est une police dite « tous risques » parce qu'une couverture moindre vous expose à des risques.
- Vérifiez ensuite auprès de l'entreprise de déménagement ce qui en est de la couverture de la valeur de remplacement. Cela signifie que l'entreprise de déménagement accepte d'être légalement responsable à hauteur d'un montant qui représente votre estimation de la valeur des biens déménagés. Ce montant est souvent déterminé en multipliant le poids (en livres) de vos biens par 10,00 \$, mais ce n'est qu'une méthode empirique. Assurez-vous que la valeur déclarée est suffisamment élevée pour remplacer tout votre mobilier et tous vos effets personnels. Assurez-vous également d'obtenir la couverture de valeur à neuf et **NON** uniquement la couverture de valeur dépréciée.
- Demandez à l'entreprise de déménagement de vous remettre de la documentation expliquant comment fonctionne la couverture de la valeur de remplacement.
- Demandez également des renseignements sur la façon de présenter une réclamation et le délai dans lequel la plainte doit être soumise.
- Renseignez-vous sur les différences entre les boîtes préparées par le propriétaire et celles qui sont préparées par l'entreprise de déménagement, et quant aux articles qui exigent des précautions spéciales (p. ex., marbre, verre et autres articles « aux risques du propriétaire » qui ne sont pas emballés par des professionnels).
- Si vous ne souscrivez pas à la couverture de valeur de remplacement, l'entreprise de déménagement n'est habituellement responsable que jusqu'à concurrence de 60 cents par livre pour les articles détruits ou perdus. (Pour un téléviseur typique, cette couverture

s'élève à environ 30 \$.)

- **Assurez-vous de bénéficier d'une protection adéquate, soit par votre propre police d'assurance ou par la couverture de valeur de remplacement de l'entreprise de déménagement.**

Pour réussir votre déménagement

- Soyez prêt lorsque les déménageurs arrivent. Assurez-vous que tout est prêt : le temps pendant lequel les déménageurs attendent vous sera facturé à l'heure.
- Assurez-vous que votre lieu de départ et votre lieu de destination sont prêts. Si vous emménagez dans un appartement, réservez l'ascenseur de l'édifice et informez le concierge ou le gérant de l'heure d'arrivée des déménageurs. Au besoin, prenez les dispositions nécessaires pour le stationnement dans la rue.
- Les *Lignes directrices sur les bonnes pratiques pour les déménageurs canadiens* stipulent que pour les déménagements long courrier, tous les articles doivent être étiquetés et inscrits sur une liste par l'entreprise de déménagement, et qu'une copie de l'inventaire doit vous être remise pour vos dossiers. Assurez-vous de conserver une copie de cet inventaire. Une fois arrivé à destination, cochez chaque article et inscrivez les modifications nécessaires sur l'inventaire avant de le signer. Sinon, le déménageur pourra refuser votre réclamation pour articles perdus ou endommagés.
- S'il s'agit d'un déménagement local, dressez un inventaire des articles à
- Assurez-vous de superviser le chargement et le déchargement, ou demandez à quelqu'un de faire la supervision. Si des articles sont perdus ou endommagés, assurez-vous d'en prendre note sur l'inventaire et informez-en rapidement l'entreprise de déménagement. Habituellement, les réclamations doivent être faites dans les trente (30) jours pour un déménagement local et dans les soixante (60) jours pour un déménagement long courrier.
- Une fois le chargement terminé, faites le tour de toutes les pièces pour vous assurer que tout a été chargé et qu'il ne reste rien dans les penderies, derrière les portes, au grenier ou dans le garage.
- Apportez vous-même tous les documents personnels et tous les documents importants. Faites une copie de sauvegarde des données de votre ordinateur et apportez vous-même l'ordinateur.
- Apportez avec vous tous vos objets de valeur (bijoux, médicaments d'ordonnance, œuvres d'art) et prenez les dispositions spéciales nécessaires pour les articles périssables (aliments, plantes) qui peuvent être affectés par la chaleur ou par le froid. 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A Tale of Two Cities — A moving story

The case history

You know the story:

- It's the day of the move.
- The movers arrive late.
- The crew is too small.
- So is the truck.
- The driver is intimidating and in a hurry.
- Calls to the mover's office are being taken by voice mail.
- Damage is done to the furnishings and the home as the crew rushes to complete the job.
- Customer-service failure follows customer-service failure.

The deck is stacked

As the reader knows, some moves, particularly inter-city moves required by a job change, come as bad news to families. One partner might have to find a new employer, the real estate market is tight, kids have to leave great friends (in their minds at the time, possibly the only friends they will ever have)...the list goes on. With a pessimistic outlook on the need for the move, such clients might approach the move itself with resentment or anger. The moving company could be a target for some of that negative feeling. A bad moving experience adds to the frustration caused by an uprooting.

Great expectations lead to great disappointment

Many moving-company customer-service reps promise a perfect move. They assure clients with such declarations as: "The fine print in the contract is just a detail; don't worry about a thing. We'll take care of everything. And if anything goes wrong, just call this number and leave a message on the answering machine."

Tales of woe find a willing audience

Such promises build great expectations which can be shattered by events beyond the control of the moving company: bad weather, mechanical failure, human error. Stuff happens.

Then the customer begins to panic. That answering machine can't solve their problems, or even give them comfort that someone is really going to check it. The panic becomes anger; the anger becomes rage. The only way to deal with it is to tell someone. Anyone. Everyone.

Service-quality-tracking data show that an angry customer will tell 12 to 18 people about their problem in the first 24 hours after a problem if it is not resolved. On the flip side, happy customers will share the good word with only two to four acquaintances.

So, what are you going to do to protect your customers, your reputation and your people from the downside of a problem event?

Underpromise and overdeliver

Make sure that the people in your company who have customer-contact responsibilities are realistic and make only commitments they can keep. Build in a margin for error. (WestJet has the best on-time record in the Canadian airline industry, because it plans and communicates arrival times with a margin for error built in. Ground crews are trained to make sure the plane takes off on time, too!)

RATER¹

Know what customers want. An intensive study conducted on service quality in a broad range of businesses identified five key customer expecta-

tions (in short form, "RATER") that provide a measurable basis for real satisfaction:

Reliability — the confidence and commitment to do what you said you would do, on time, on budget;

Assurance — the sense that comes from communicating with your people that they have the will and the skill to conduct business professionally and respectfully;

Tangibles — the positive reaction that comes from physical appearance of the people, equipment and literature that defines your business;

Empathy — the sense that your people care about customers; and

Responsiveness — resolution of issues and meeting of commitments without delay.

Have a receptionist, not a 'deceptionist'

I think there is a special place in hell for the inventor of voice mail. Yes, it has saved us the money we used to spend on people who exclusively answered our phones, and it sometimes calms our customers, spouses and colleagues. However, when the costs of potential lost business, hurt feelings, broken promises and the sense of outrage that comes from talking to a machine during a perceived crisis are taken into consideration, voice mail will surely be one of the most-expensive money-saving devices ever invented. High tech needs high touch.

Make sure your customers can contact a person — on a hot line if need be. And not just anyone. It must be a person who knows how to deal with anger and frustration on the other end of the line, and who can calm and

La situation typique

Le dossier d'antécédents

On connaît tous l'histoire :

- C'est le jour du déménagement.
- Les déménageurs arrivent en retard.
- L'équipe de déménageurs n'est pas assez nombreuse.
- Le camion n'est pas assez grand.
- Le chauffeur est impatient et pressé.
- Au bureau de la compagnie de déménagement, c'est un système de messagerie vocale qui prend les appels.
- Les meubles et la maison ont subi des dommages à cause de la précipitation des déménageurs à finir le travail au plus vite.
- Les failles dans le service à la clientèle s'enchaînent.

Les dés sont pipés

L'annonce d'un déménagement, surtout quand il s'agit de déplacer une famille dans une autre ville à cause d'un changement d'emploi, n'est pas toujours accueillie comme une bonne nouvelle. Le déménagement peut obliger l'autre conjoint à chercher un nouvel emploi, peut avoir lieu alors que le marché de l'immobilier n'est pas favorable, peut contraindre les enfants à quitter leurs amis (les enfants ont souvent l'impression qu'ils n'en auront plus jamais)... et quoi encore. Quand le client déménage à contrecœur, il peut éprouver du ressentiment et de la colère. Dans de tels cas, l'entreprise de déménagement peut devenir une cible de choix pour exprimer ses sentiments négatifs. Une mauvaise expérience de déménagement ajoute à la frustration causée par le déracinement.

Les grandes attentes mènent à de grandes désillusions.

De nombreux représentants du service à la clientèle des entreprises de déménagement promettent un déménagement parfait. Ils rassurent les clients en leur disant par exemple : « Le texte en petits caractères dans le contrat n'est que formalité. Ne vous inquiétez pas, nous

nous occupons de tout. Si tout ne se déroule pas à votre goût, vous n'avez qu'à téléphoner à ce numéro et à laisser un message sur le répondeur. »

Les mauvaises nouvelles courrent vite

Puis l'inévitable survient. Des événements indépendants de la volonté des entreprises de déménagement, comme le mauvais temps, des bris mécaniques ou l'erreur humaine viennent décevoir les grandes attentes. Des choses qui arrivent.

C'est là que le client commence à paniquer. Le système de messagerie vocale n'est d'aucun secours pour régler ses problèmes ni même lui garantir que quelqu'un va vraiment faire quelque chose. La panique se transforme en colère, puis en rage. La seule façon d'exprimer sa frustration c'est d'en parler à quelqu'un, à n'importe qui et à tout le monde.

Selon les résultats d'enquêtes menées sur la qualité du service, le client dont le problème n'est pas réglé rapidement racontera son histoire à entre 12 et 18 personnes dans les 24 premières heures suivant l'événement. Par contre, les clients satisfaits n'en parleront qu'à deux ou trois personnes de leur entourage.

Que faire pour protéger vos clients, votre réputation et votre personnel des conséquences découlant d'un problème survenu au cours du déménagement?

Promettez-en moins et donnez-en plus

Voyez à ce que les employés qui ont des contacts directs avec les clients soient现实istes et à ce qu'ils ne prennent que des engagements qu'ils peuvent tenir. Établissez une marge d'erreurs. (WestJet a le meilleur dossier de ponctualité de l'industrie aérienne au pays parce qu'elle planifie les heures d'arrivée en prévoyant automatiquement une marge d'erreur. De plus, les équipages au sol sont formés pour s'assurer que les avions décollent à temps.)

RATER¹

Savez-vous ce que les clients veulent? Une vaste étude menée sur la qualité du service dans un éventail d'entreprises a permis d'identifier les cinq principales attentes des clients (« RATER ») et de créer un outil de mesure de la satisfaction réelle des clients.

Fiabilité (Reliability) — l'engagement que vous ferez ce que vous avez promis de faire, à temps et dans les budgets prévus;

Assurance (Assurance) — l'assurance que les employés ont la volonté et la compétence nécessaires pour faire le travail avec professionnalisme et respect;

Présence d'éléments tangibles (Tangibles) — la réaction positive que suscite l'apparence physique des employés, de l'équipement et des documents qui décrivent votre entreprise;

Empathie (Empathy) — le sentiment que vos employés ont à cœur les intérêts des clients; et

Serviabilité (Responsiveness) — la certitude que vous réglerez les problèmes et remplirez les engagements sans retard.

Un système téléphonique efficace et non pas une source de frustration

Je pense que l'inventeur de la messagerie vocale n'a pas toujours la cote. Bien sûr, les systèmes de messagerie vocale permettent aux entreprises d'économiser le salaire d'une personne dont la seule fonction était de répondre au téléphone et, bien sûr, ils réussissent parfois à satisfaire les clients, les conjoints et les collègues. Cependant, lorsqu'on tient compte du prix à payer pour la perte éventuelle de clients, pour les déceptions, pour les promesses non tenues et pour la frustration que certaines personnes ressentent à parler à une machine alors qu'ils sont dans un fâcheuse situation, les systèmes de messagerie vocale sont certainement les appareils conçus pour faire réaliser des économies les moins rentables jamais inventés. Les hautes

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assure callers that their issues will be dealt with effectively. See RATER, above, for details.

Make it a system

Be sure that not only your customer-service people have the skills to deal with customers. Anyone with customer contact can and will destroy good will if they are not willing and able to communicate effectively with customers. Important skills for anyone with customer contact include:

- Establishing rapport
- Calming and focusing an upset customer
- Listening and asking questions to resolve problems
- Making recommendations and confirming mutual action plans
- Overcoming obstacles
- Confirming understanding and agreement
- Following up

There are many ways to build these skills, and investment made here will go much further in building your reputation and profitability than buying advertising and making commitments you can't deliver on.

Be clear/walk the talk

Make sure that everyone in your organization knows that satisfied customers are the best advertisers you could ever have. And don't send mixed messages. If customer satisfaction is important, don't reward the biggest sale and ignore the best move. Focus your *organization* on customer satisfaction, and make it real by focusing *your actions* on employee satisfaction. After all, it takes dedicated employees to create dedicated customers.

Make it so

Just like the commander of the Starship Enterprise, be sure that, when you do encounter a problem, you take personal responsibility to not just fix the problem, but make it right in the eyes of the customer and your employees. A small investment in making it right for the customer can become a major step to ensuring goodwill over time. And don't be too busy to call the customer to make sure

things are okay. Do it before they call someone else.

If you and your organization are able to focus on customer satisfaction as a principle for business success, then you can say, as Dickens' protagonist did in *A Tale of Two Cities*, "***It is a far, far better thing that I do, than I have ever done!***"¹²

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technologies nécessitent une réponse humaine compensatoire.

Assurez-vous que vos clients peuvent parler à quelqu'un en instaurant par exemple un service d'assistance téléphonique. Ne confiez pas le poste de préposé au service d'assistance téléphonique à n'importe qui. Il faut que cette personne sache comment réagir face à la colère et à la frustration du client au bout du fil. Elle doit également être formée pour assurer aux clients que leur problème sera réglé efficacement. Pour plus de détails, voir la rubrique RATER ci-dessus.

Faites-en une politique générale

Voyez à ce que le personnel du service à la clientèle ne soit pas le seul à avoir les qualités nécessaires pour traiter avec les clients. N'importe quel employé qui a des contacts avec les clients peut détruire votre réputation s'il n'arrive pas à communiquer efficacement avec les clients. Tous les employés en contact avec les clients devraient être formés pour :

- Établir des rapports
- Rassurer un client en colère
- Écouter et poser les bonnes questions pour résoudre les problèmes
- Faire des recommandations et confirmer les plans d'action de chacune des parties
- Surmonter les obstacles
- S'assurer que tout le monde se comprend et est d'accord
- Faire le suivi

Il existe de nombreuses façons de former les employés. Les sommes

consacrées à la formation contribueront beaucoup plus efficacement à bâtir votre réputation et à assurer votre rentabilité que celles dépensées en publicité et en promesses que vous ne pouvez pas tenir.

Soyez clair/respectez vos promesses

Rappelez à vos employés que les clients satisfaits font la meilleure publicité du monde à votre entreprise. Soyez conséquent dans vos actes. Si la satisfaction de la clientèle est importante, ne récompensez pas le meilleur vendeur sans faire de même avec ceux et celles qui ont réussi le meilleur déménagement. Axez l'ensemble de votre *entreprise* sur la satisfaction de la clientèle et posez des gestes concrets pour satisfaire vos employés. Après tout, les clients qui ont fait affaire avec des employés consciencieux reviennent.

Prenez la situation en main

Faites comme si vous étiez le capitaine d'un navire et, en cas de problème, prenez personnellement la responsabilité non seulement de le régler mais de le régler correctement aux yeux du client et de vos employés. Un petit investissement pour résoudre correctement le problème d'un client peut être un atout important pour gagner une clientèle à long terme. Et prenez le temps d'appeler le client pour vous assurer qu'il est satisfait. Faites-le avant qu'il appelle quelqu'un d'autre.

Si votre entreprise et vous faites de la satisfaction de la clientèle un principe fondamental pour réussir en affaires, vous pourrez dire à l'instar d'un personnage de Dickens dans *Le conte des deux villes* : "***C'est de loin la meilleure chose que j'ai faite... !***"¹²

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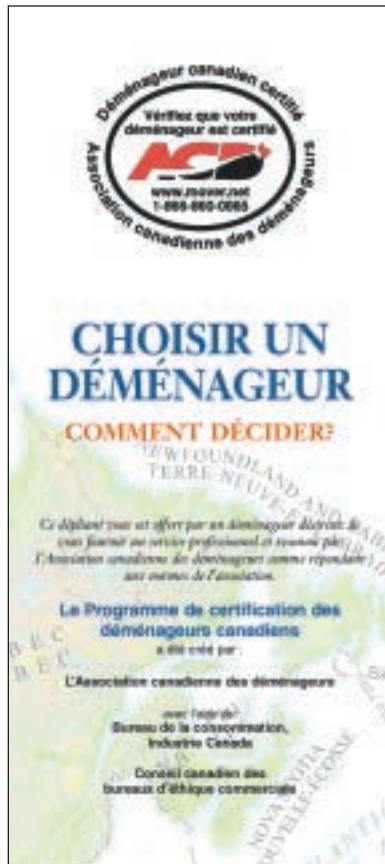
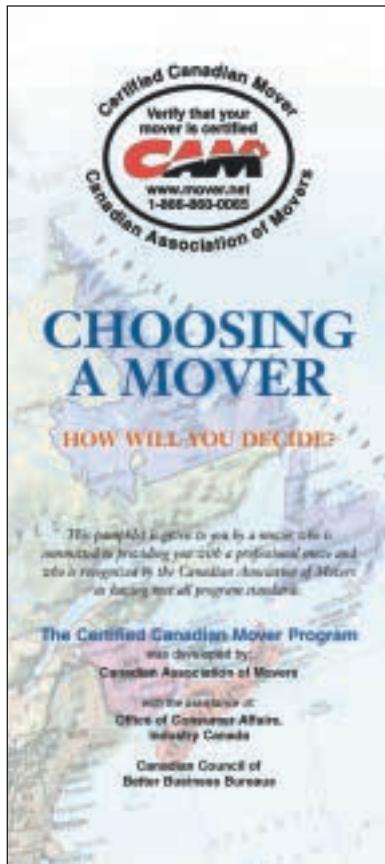
