CAM'S COMPENSATION SURVEY

Thanks to everyone who took time to complete the survey. The results of CAM's compensation survey are now complete and have been emailed to all member participants.

The survey provides a unique view of the wages and salaries that are being paid in our industry.

Useable information was generated for BC, Vancouver, Alberta, Saskatchewan–Manitoba, Ontario, Toronto, Burlington–Mississauga, Ottawa region, Quebec and Montreal as well as statistics for across Canada.

The responses to some survey questions and from some geographic areas were limited. This prevented the publishing of results for those questions and those areas. We were unable to provide benefit/pension information based on the information received.

Respondents indicated that completing the survey was relatively easy and took an average of 16 minutes. Several respondents made very useful suggestions. These will be incorporated into future surveys. The next time the survey is run, we should be able to provide information on more regions and more areas of interest.

PROPOSED CHANGES TO RULES FOR WOOD PACKAGING MATERIAL MOVING BETWEEN CANADA AND USA

The Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) and U.S. Department of Agriculture, Animal & Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) are developing a strategy that would involve a multi-year phase-in period for an eventual full implementation of the International Standard for Phytosanitary Measures (ISPM) No. 15 for wood packaging material (WPM) moving between the two countries. All WPM moving between Canada and the United States would be required to be treated in accordance with the ISPM No. 15 standard and marked with an officially-approved mark, as is the case for WPM moving in international trade.

Industry, stakeholders, exporters, importers, brokers, wood packaging manufacturers and interest groups are encouraged to provide comments on this proposed strategy to CFIA within the next 90 days. Details of the announcement can be seen on CAM's website in the [members-only area](#).

Ontario's Consumer Protection Act

On October 7, 2008, CAM representatives met with Ontario's Ministry of Small Business and Consumer Affairs regarding the practices in the moving industry. Most of the moving industry's questions about the Consumer Protection Act were covered in the meeting that CAM held with the Ministry in August 2005. Notes on both meetings can be seen on our website.

Members should be aware that they are subject to the Act if their company is resident in Ontario, or a shipment occurs within, into or out of Ontario.

The Ministry stressed the importance of ensuring that the consumer understands the moving contract. It is proceeding with investigations and prosecutions of movers who violate the Act.
