Date: Monday, September 14, 2020

Location: Carlisle Golf & Country Club

Carlisle ON (20 minutes north of Burlington)

Time: No shotgun this year. Instead it will be a double split tee off format from the 1st hole and 10th

hole based on a maximum of 40 golfers starting at 11 am.

This is a new start time! Originally it was 12:30 pm.

- Currently, players are asked to arrive 20 minutes prior to tee off time. We will likely be given some leeway as you'll need to register at the registration desk and then bring your clubs down to your assigned cart. At that time, you may also want to get your lunch from the Halfway House.
- All golfers must individually check in at the registration desk with name & phone number for contact tracing purposes. At that time, each golfer will have a health screening done (similar to the ones you have been asking your clients.) Please do not come to the golf course if you are unwell, or have had exposure to someone with the virus in the previous 2 weeks.
- The golf course (at this time) doesn't want you arriving too early and congregating around the pro shop area. Social distancing protocols will be in place.
- Carts will be assigned to you by CAM. You are to tell us if you are having a cart by yourself or are sharing it with someone on your team. There are enough carts for each person to have their own. CAM will have your cart identified with signage.
- Carlisle staff will not carry or load your bags in the cart. That will be up to you. The bag
 drop area is adjacent to the parking lot, so you won't have far to lug.



Bag drop area is adjacent to the parking lot at Carlisle


On Course:

The following are going to be in place for this year only. There may be some last-minute opportunity to change this, but for now:

- There will be no competitions, games or skill contests. No winners or losers, hole-in-one competitions, closest to the line, etc.
- You are limited to only using your own clubs and balls. No sharing. So, unfortunately there will be no Victory Ball game this year.
- Just straight golf. No best ball. So you can even make up your own scoring system within the foursome.

Food & Bev: CAM will provide Lunch, 2 Drink tickets, and Post Game munchie

- At this time, you cannot show up an hour early to mingle around and have your lunch
- Lunch will be take-out through the Half Way House hamburger, hot dog, sausage plus chips and a pop/water. You can either get it before your tee off time; take it in your cart and munch along the way; or pick it up when you go through to the other half of the course
- Beer cart will be going around you will get 2 drink tickets for alcoholic/non-alcoholic drinks (besides the pop/water you get with your meals)
- There will be a 19th hole the outdoor patio will hold 40 and you will be expected to sit with your team at one of the tables and not switch around or stand and chat at another table. There will be a post game munchie (for example: fancy chicken sandwich, chips/chocolate bar and pop/water). You will have the option of eating it at the patio, or they will box the whole thing up for you to take home.

- The patio will be reserved for our exclusive use and will be thoroughly wiped down and prepared for your use. Nancy will be supervising that just prior to your arrival off the course.
- If regulations change and we can have more people indoors by September 14th (and who really knows?), we *may* take it inside.

Precautions: Here's the current COVID stuff

- Do not come to the golf course if you are unwell, or have had exposure to someone with the virus in the previous 2 weeks.
- A health check will be done at the registration desk. You will be asked to sign
 a form stating that to the best of your knowledge you are well. A
 thermometer will be available to check temperatures.
- Mask to be worn in or near the clubhouse or when 6 feet distancing cannot be maintained
- You do not have to wear a mask on the course while golfing.
- Only handle your own clubs and golf balls. Do not share.
- One mask and individualized hand sanitizer will be provided by CAM at registration.
- Hand sanitizer will also be available on each table at the 19th hole.
