

## Health & Safety Protocols – Know Before You Go

We are committed to producing a safe event for our attendees and staff. We are carefully monitoring government guidelines and public health regulations to ensure the event will be a safe place to interact and conduct business.

As part of our commitment, we have developed safety protocols and best practices around COVID-19 response and prevention which is being updated as more information and guidance becomes available. We ask all those attending to follow the attendance requirements and help us host a safe and successful event.

### *Prior to the Event:*

- If you feel sick, are experiencing any signs, symptoms or have recently been exposed to, or diagnosed and not yet cleared by provincial health authorities as non-contagious with COVID-19, please do not come to the event.
- Please don't forget your own face covering.

### *Arriving at the Event:*

- Attendees will be required to provide proof of their full vaccination (14 days after your second dose) to access the event, unless you have a medical exemption. Proof of full vaccination can be provided from a mobile device or a hard copy along with government-issued photo ID.
- Attendees and staff are required to complete a COVID-19 screening questionnaire in accordance with the Ministry of Health and provide contact tracing information. This will be completed by scanning a QR code and answering questions or questions will be asked verbally if the QR Code isn't usable.

### *During the Event:*

- Face covering must be worn at all times in public areas. Should you forget your own face covering, one will be provided.
- The 6 feet of social distancing is recommended, wherever possible.
- There will be hand sanitizers that will be accessible for all in attendance.
- There will be signage throughout as a reminder of safety protocols.
- The event space will be cleaned more frequently, and regular disinfecting will take place to sanitize public areas.
